III. DATE, VENUE

The event will take place on Friday, May 24, 2024, at the First Warsaw Golf course in Rajszew and its surroundings, Mazowieckie Voivodeship.

All participants will receive commemorative medals at the finish line.

20:00 - 01:00 Black & White Party at the Boathouse Restaurant

21:30 - presentation of personalized trophies to the winners

We invite all interested parties to participate according to the categories of each distance.

*estimated time, subject to change due to the number of participants, special circumstances, or adverse weather conditions.

Participation:

Only adults have the right to participate in the races.

Participants are advised to undergo medical checks before the event.

Decisions regarding medical care during the event are final and irrevocable.

Only participants registered in accordance with this Regulation ("Participants") may participate in the races.

Only Participants, Event staff, and vehicles with Organizer passes are allowed on the race route.

Time measurement and determination of the order of Participants who have completed the race will be carried out electronically using special chips attached to the shoe lace. Return chip at the finish line. The Organizer has the right to impose a penalty of 10.00 PLN gross for an unreturned chip.

Participants must strictly follow the designated race route marked with arrows, tapes, and follow the instructions of the Event staff.

Race participants are obliged to observe public order, instructions from Security Services, and respect other Participants.

IV. RACE ROUTES / TIME LIMIT

During the event, a total of 2 races will take place.

Friday, May 24, 2024:

10:30 5 km race for adults.

Route length: 5 km (one loop), untested route.

Surface: 100% dirt road.

Time limit: 90 minutes

10:30 10 km race for adults.

Route length: 10 km (one loop), untested route.

Surface: 100% dirt road.

Time limit: 90 minutes

The route will be marked with arrows and signaling tape. Technical Support members and medical staff will be stationed at critical points.

There are no watering points along the race routes. Water will be distributed at the race finish line.

All participants must be verified at the Race Office. During verification, participants must present an ID card or other document confirming their identity.

The condition for admitting a competitor to the race will be signing a declaration of participation in the competition at their own risk, awareness of their health condition, knowledge of the event regulations, and consent to the processing of personal data for the needs of the event, as well as for the use of the participant's image captured in the form of a photograph or video recording. Information regarding personal data protection is available in section IX of these Regulations.

VII. CLASSIFICATIONS AND AWARDS

The winners of places I - III in the above classifications will receive trophies.

All classifications are based on gross times, from the starting signal to crossing the finish line.

Classifications:

10:30 5 km race for adults.

- Each participant will receive a commemorative medal at the finish line.
- Electronic time measurement.
- Awarded categories (top three places):
- Open Female, Open Male
- Team Frequency Combined for 5 and 10 km distances (the most numerous team according to the team name provided during registration; in case of the same number of people at the finish line, the higher place of the fastest person in the team is counted)

10:30 10 km race for adults.

- Each participant will receive a commemorative medal at the finish line.
- Electronic time measurement.
- Awarded categories (top three places):

-Open Female, Open Male

-Sports Team for the 10 km distance (total time, a three-person team with the same team name (including at least 1 woman). Each member of the running team is also an individual participant,

starting separately, but their times are summed up for the team result. The team consists of at least one woman.

- Team Frequency Combined for 5 and 10 km distances (the most numerous team according to the team name provided during registration; in case of the same number of people at the finish line,

the higher place of the fastest person in the team is counted)

VIII. FINAL PROVISIONS

The event will take place regardless of weather conditions.

The event may not take place due to flood risk (official ban by the area manager – Regional Water Management Board in Warsaw).

The Organizer provides medical care on the race route and at the finish line, during and immediately after the race.

Race participants move along the race routes according to general traffic rules.

Race participants are not covered by additional insurance. It is the Participant's responsibility to ensure adequate insurance.

The Organizer is not responsible for accidents occurring during participants' travel to and from the event.

Transferring one's race number to another person with their consent results in disqualification of the Participant as well as the person to whom the Participant transferred the number. During the race, competitors must have race numbers attached to their outerwear at the front, at chest level or waist level.

The right to participate in the race cannot be transferred to third parties or exchanged for money.

Written protests regarding the organization or results of the races should be addressed to the Race Organizing Office within 30 minutes of the race ending. Protests will be reviewed immediately. After this time, race results become official.

Participants acknowledge and agree that the Organizer reserves the right to refuse a Participant's participation in the races if the Participant does not comply with the provisions of these Regulations, instructions from the Organizer's staff, or representatives of the Organizer during the race.

The Organizer is not responsible for items left or lost.

The Organizer reserves the right to publish race results, publish reports on the course of the event, and publish photos on websites, in the press, and on television.

Each participant competes at their own risk.

For safety reasons and participants' comfort, there is no possibility of starting with a dog or using Nordic Walking poles during the event.

In all matters not covered by the Regulations, the Organizer of the event decides.

name and surname, gender, represented team, email address, phone number, image.

Personal data will be processed and stored for as long as necessary for the conduct of the Administrator's activities in accordance with the law, taking into account their archiving or until the consent is revoked if other provisions do not exclude this, but not longer than for a period of 5 years from the date of participation in the described event.

Personal data will be entrusted for processing on the basis of a separate agreement to other entities processing data, including: Superczas.pl – Sports Time Measurement (WKR FAN Association from Olsztyn) and subcontractors, with such entities processing data based on an agreement with the Administrator and solely in accordance with the Administrator's instructions, and the processing of personal data will take into account the necessary security measures. Personal data may also be made available to Event Partners and Sponsors.

Personal data will not be transferred further.

You have the right to access your data and the right to request their rectification, deletion, or restriction of processing.

To the extent that data is processed, you also have the right to data portability, i.e., to receive from the Administrator personal data in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable format. You may transfer this data to another data controller.

Personal data will not be subject to automated processing.
