

RULES

23rd Annual EUROBUILD Golf Tournament

May 24, 2024

§ 1. General Provisions

The organizer of the 23rd Annual EUROBUILD Golf Tournament ("Golf Tournament") is EuroCEE Sp. z o.o. and First Warsaw Golf Rajszew.

The Golf Tournament will take place on May 24, 2024, at First Warsaw Golf in the town of Rajszew. The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the rules of R&A Rules Ltd.

The Golf Tournament will be conducted under the supervision of the Tournament Committee (hereinafter referred to as the "Tournament Committee"), consisting of:

Representative of Eurobuild CEE - Anna Pelczarska

Representative of the golf course: Elżbieta Ptasińska

Members of the Tournament Committee may participate in the Golf Tournament. The members of the Tournament Committee will select a Chairman from among themselves.

The Tournament Committee has the exclusive right to interpret these Regulations. Resolutions of the Tournament Committee are final.

§ 2. Players

Players must also meet all the following criteria:

Players confirmed their participation by May 24, 2024

Players have amateur status in golf,

Players have a Golf Handicap within the range: from 0 to 36.

The Tournament Committee may allow the participation in the tournament of a player with a HCP 36.1 - 54 or a player possessing only a Green Card. During scoring, such a player will be treated as having a HCP 36.

The Golf Tournament will be attended by a maximum of 100 people. Admission of a person to the group of players is determined by the order of applications, as mentioned in § 1 point 5 above.

§ 3. Rules and Golf Etiquette:

The Golf Tournament will be played according to the Rules of Golf approved by R&A Rules Limited and according to the Local Rules approved by the Tournament Committee.

Any player who flagrantly violates the etiquette of the game (throwing clubs or using vulgar expressions) may be disqualified after a prior, one-time warning. The decision to apply such a penalty may be made by the referee based on their own assessment of the situation (Reg. 33-7).

If the above violation of etiquette is committed by a caddie, the penalty is borne by the player who employs them.

§ 3b. Golf Clubs and Balls:

Golf clubs and balls used in the tournament must be approved for amateur play by the R&A (www.randa.org/rules/equipement).

§ 3c. Electronic Equipment:

a.) The use of walkie-talkies, mobile phones, and pagers during the game is prohibited. The use of mobile phones is allowed only to contact the referee or the Tournament Committee.

b.) The use of electronic distance-measuring devices is permitted, provided that they cannot measure values such as: differences in elevation, temperature, wind speed, and direction. Devices with additional options are prohibited, even if not used during the game. Reg. 14-3

§ 4. Tournament Format, Tee:

The tournament is a one-day event and will be played on 18 holes. The tournament will be conducted in strokeplay net and gross formats as well as stableford net.

Tee (taking into account the length changes allowed by EGA):

Men - yellow,

Women - red.

§ 6. Suspension of Play Due to Dangerous Situation (note to Reg. 6-8b):

The Tournament Committee may announce the suspension of play in potentially dangerous conditions as follows:

Immediate suspension of play: one long signal of the siren:

If players are between holes, they must not start play until it is resumed by the Tournament Committee. If players are in the middle of playing a hole, they must immediately stop play and act in accordance with Reg. 6-8.c. If a player does not stop play immediately, they will be disqualified, unless circumstances warrant otherwise, according to Reg. 33-7.

Suspension of play: three consecutive signals of the siren:

If players are between holes, they must not start play until it is resumed by the Tournament Committee. If players are in the middle of playing a hole, they may suspend play immediately or continue, provided they do so without delay. If they decide to continue playing the current hole, they may suspend it at any time before completing the hole, in accordance with Reg.6-8.c. In any case, play must be suspended after completing the current hole.

Resumption of play: two short signals of the siren:

Players must resume play when the Tournament Committee announces its resumption.

§ 7. Winners of the Golf Tournament and Awards:

The following places will be awarded in two HCP groups:

Group I HCP precise 0-18

strokeplay gross classification - 1st place

strokeplay net classification - 1st, 2nd, 3rd place

Group II HCP precise 18.1 - 36.0

stableford net classification - 1st, 2nd, 3rd place

Additionally:

Ladies Longest Drive - hole 11

Men Longest Drive - hole 9

Closest to the Pin (women and men combined) - hole 14

Tie - in case of players achieving identical results, the order in the classification is determined by:

better score on the second nine holes

in case of no resolution by the above method, the better score on the last 6 holes

in case of no resolution by the above method, the better score on the last 3 holes

in case of no resolution by the above method, the better score on the last hole

§ 8. Self-Driving Golf Carts (Melex type):

The use of self-driving golf carts during the tournament round is permitted.

§ 9. Electric Golf Carts:

Electric carts are allowed.

§ 10. Caddies:

Each player may have one caddie at a time (Rule 6-4), with the provision that during the round, a person related to a junior player may not in any way assist or advise them in the game.

The penalty for breaking the above rule is:

for the first offense: two penalty strokes Reg. 8-1.,

for the second offense: disqualification Reg. 33-7.

§ 11. Changes to the Golf Tournament Regulations:

The Contest Organizer reserves the right to change the regulations at any time before the start of the first round of the Golf Tournament. Changes to the regulations made just

before the start of the Tournament will be published in the Tournament Center and announced to the players by the Tournament Committee.
